JUDGMENT

The matter came for trial on March 31, 2021, and for subsequent hearing on the wording of the judgment and attorney fees on July 19, 2021, pursuant to previous assignment.

Considering the pleadings, applicable law, exhibits, evidence, testimony, and for the reasons stated in the court's written reasons for judgment related to the March 31, 2021 trial, and the reasons for judgment related to the July 19, 2021 hearing, the court renders judgment follows:

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that there be judgment in favor of Plaintiff, Elsbet Smith, against Defendant, Seale & Ross, PLC, in the amount of \$12,828.42 in owed production bonus wages and an additional \$39,961.80 in penalties.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that there be judgment in favor of Plaintiff, Frank DiVittorio, against Defendant, Seale & Ross, PLC, in the amount of \$3,516.78 in owed production bonus wages and an additional \$38,399.40 in penalties.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiffs, Elsbet Smith and Frank DiVittorio are awarded judicial interest from January 19, 2017, the date of demand, until paid on all judgment amounts detailed above, and that the Defendant, Seale & Ross, PLC is cast for all costs in the matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED that there be judgment in favor of Defendant Seale & Ross, PLC and against Plaintiff, Jennifer Lee, dismissing her claims, with prejudice.

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
